

2022 JUNIOR TOURNAMENT FAQ's

ENTRIES:

Entries close 7pm, Friday 2nd December 2022 (or as otherwise advised), and can be lodged by visiting the Pro-shop or using the link here:

ELIGIBILITY:

Players must be registered, financial HKDTA members for the 2022/2023 membership year.

Players who are financial participants of the Term 4, 2022 Friday Juniors program will have their fees waived for this tournament.

Cost of entry will be \$10 per match paid in full at time of registration. Registration without payment will NOT be accepted.

The committee reserves the right to grade and or re-grade any player at any time. For all Junior Age events, a date of birth must be written on the entry form to be accepted into a draw.

Players need to have reached the age specified on the event being played, before 9th December, 2022. [I.E: A child born on 9th Dec 2011 will be 11 years old and register for the 12 & Under age group.]

Events will only proceed should a minimum number of entries is received. Organisers reserve the right to combine age and gender events at their sole discretion to provide an opportunity for participation.

Entry to doubles events require a partner to be nominated. Players entering without a nominated partner will only be added to the draw if a partner is assigned and even numbers of entries are received.

DRAW:

Our schedule and draws will be prepared following acceptances. Only paid and registered members will be accepted, and NO entries will be accepted after 7pm on the 2nd of December 2022.

Matches are planned to be completed on Friday 9th December [4pm – 9pm] & Friday 16th December -[4pm-9pm]

The schedule and draw will be posted via the website and printed in the pro shop. www.superbtennis.com.au

Any changes to this schedule will be at the discretion of the organisers.

MATCH PLAY:

Any competitor not ready to play at the appointed time, or alternatively, at the conclusion of the prior fixture will be forfeited from the event.

Players will self score and umpire each match with line calls made promptly with loud verbal and non verbal calls made promptly for the opponent to see and hear.

Server is to call the score after each point and at the conclusion of each game.

Players must accept any umpire appointed by the Tournament Committee. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to amend these structures if necessary prior to the commencement of any event.

CONTROL:

The Tournament shall be entirely under the control of the Tournament Committee, which will exercise the duties and powers of a referee. The tournament shall be conducted according to these rules. The Tournament Committee has the right to reject any entry without explanation and also has the power to disqualify any competitor whose conduct during the tournament is, in the opinion of the Committee, deserving of censure. The Committee reserves the right to amalgamate events should there be insufficient entries in any particular Division.

WET WEATHER: Tournament Committee will make a decision as early as possible. Decisions on play/ no play are final.
