Message from the President:

Happy Easter everybody!

As I was overseas for Christmas and didn't wish you all Merry Christmas, I'm getting in a bit early for Easter!

January, February and March were busy for many Committee members, attending a number of Tennis NSW events that they have put on to provide assistance and advice to tennis clubs on ways to improve the tennis experience for all. We also installed in early March an electronic locking system at Berowra to better control court access, and will update you further on that next month.

Your Committee has also been busy working in smaller subcommittees to review many areas of operation in HKDTA and to put together plans for improvements and future developments. You will see later in this newsletter a revised program for Wednesday night social tennis that the **"Social Tennis"** subcommittee has put together, the **"Paid services"** subcommittee is putting together a proposal to refine the way that we engage contractors to provide services which we will discuss at our next full Committee meeting, and other sub committees are working through their issues.

There are two more subcommittees that I am asking for volunteers from outside the committee to join to provide a different perspective. One is the "**Competitions**" subcommittee, which will be looking at the types of competitions we are offering, and what alternatives there might be. The other is the "**Berowra**" subcommittee which will be closely involved in all aspects of running our Berowra tennis centre. Being involved in these sub committees doesn't need to take a huge amount of your time, basically we would probably meet once, have some general discussions around the ideas we want to explore, and then mostly discuss further via email, and then present any recommended plans for action to the full Committee. If you aren't going away, we offer school holiday camps both at Mills Park and Berowra, and although most comps will be having a break, the courts are ready and waiting for you!





From 11 March 2019 the method of booking, payment and access to the four tennis courts at our Berowra centre has changed. An electronic locking system was installed, which will unlock the gate, and turn on the lights if required, for each court that is booked. The system is connected to our existing on-line court booking and payment system. This improvement is being made to make the Berowra centre more financially viable, and to provide better access to court hire at Berowra.

It is not cost effective to have someone permanently attending the Berowra centre as a manager. This new system will enable the courts at Berowra to be open for most of the day without the need for supervision, and will ensure that only people who have a booked a court are playing there. We do anticipate that this system will result in an increase in revenue generated at Berowra.

Players can book and pay for court hire using a computer or on their smart phone or tablet. If necessary, bookings and payments can also be made by phoning our Mills Park centre at Asquith on 9482 1370. Cash payments at Berowra will cease, which will eliminate the risk of cash theft from the clubhouse.
