Message from the President:

In the report from the Treasurer that was circulated last week you will have read the reference to a need for more volunteers to assist with some aspects of running our club. This is crucial for us as a club to continue to improve the services we offer. As you will see in our strategic plan, we have much more that we want to achieve in the future, and I look forward to many more club members coming on board for the journey as we work to achieve those goals.

FINANCIAL UPDATE from the Treasurer:

Hi Members

I am pleased to report, that after recording a loss last year, four months into the current financial year, we have now returned to a profitable situation.

At one stage our financial situation was looking catastrophic to me, as we have massive capital commitments looming. In particular, we need to replace all 14 court surfaces over the next five years. A quick return to profit was critical if we were to start accumulating the funds required to meet this commitment.

However, initiatives taken over the last 12 months appear to have put the club back on track. While it is early to make a call on this, I feel a lot more comfortable about our situation than I did a couple of months ago.

Considered a bit too long for inclusion in this ATC, I have separately sent members a more detailed report to provide background on our financial situation and actions taken by the Committee to address this. I hope some of you will be interested to read that report, although, I warn you now that the report is a Halloween edition and includes some true scary stories.
