

Our AGM in November 2023 saw new faces in the committee volunteer to represent the members of Superb Tennis on the committee.

Ros brings experience and skills in working with not for profits and councils to the role as well as a lifelong love of tennis.

Kaska Musial [Vice President], Lyall Pogue [Treasurer] are also new additions to the office bearer team. Both have been active members of the club for many years and bring a wealth of skill, knowledge and passion to the club's' operations.

Thanks also go to Margaret Stirling [Secretary] for stepping up to an office bearing position from the role as a general committee member. Having served in this role in the past, Margaret brings a wealth of experience to this team.

Our general committee membership has remained largely unchanged with Stuart Hillier, Theresa Johnson, Laneth Bissett and Mike Taher Mehri continuing their contribution.

IN TENNIS

Following a successful phase of court and complex rejuvenation, our strategic plan's priorities have now begun to focus on the people.

Following an extensive review of operations, Superb Tennis will be using a new system at Mills Park and Berowra.

We have chosen to partner with Sports Logic to deliver systems that manage the courts, club, membership, coaching and point of sale.

Known as "InTennis", the application is used by over 300 venues in Australia with Mills Park and Berowra Tennis Centres using its full operations from July 1, 2024.

Whilst we cannot wait to deliver this new experience, we understand the impact change can have to some. The committee and operations team are confident that this change will bring positive differences to the club. The way we do things today will be different tomorrow. We are preparing to minimise the impact of that change as we work towards its implementation.



BARCLAY CONSULTING

As a result of the operational review, we have decided to cease our partnership with Barclay Consulting.

Roger and Beth Barclay have been supporting our operations since the early 2000s, providing an online court booking system, locking system, membership database and event registration for us and many of our neighbours in the tennis sphere.

Rogers' skills and knowledge in delivering hardware and software components to operators is respected at the highest levels of tennis and the IT industry. The Barclays have been on call 24/7/365 to support the club. No small effort and their assistance has been greatly valued and appreciated.

The Tennis BCS system we currently use is planned to cease live operations with Superb Tennis on July 1, 2024.

We want to thank the Barclays for their efforts and long-term support for the club. We continue to be advocates for their systems and look forward to seeing their business continue to show strength and value in a market they are clear leaders in.



COURT BOOKING AUTOMATION



Whilst Berowra Tennis Centre has had automated court access and lights for a while, Mills Park has been quietly waiting its turn.

Commencing July 1, 2024, Mills Park will also deliver automated access and light controls to your online court bookings. This will provide a more streamlined approach to bookings and enable courts to be used at times when the centre is not currently open. Further details on how this will operate will be set out as we approach July 1.

Our Centre Management team will be monitoring the change in the first few weeks and assist with our transition.

The terms and conditions with which members and visitors book and use our courts will also be updated. We have recently seen a rise in:

- customers not paying before, during or after play
- customers using a different court to the one booked
- customers playing past their allotted booking period
- customers paying for courts and using/coaching not affiliated with Superb Tennis

These events impact YOUR CLUB and its ongoing feasibility. Strict and swift action will impact the members or guests that cannot adhere to the terms and conditions they agree to when purchasing court time. Our volunteer committee do not want to have to convene for disciplinary actions. Please support the club that supports you and do the right thing on site.

In addition, work to improve the security of the Berowra Tennis Complex is scheduled. Vandalism, negligence and apathy from court users at Berowra has led to significant numbers of our customers using our facilities without paying. This has an impact on the ability of your club to function as needed. Your help in ensuring that the security gates and court hire are properly used, is fundamental to the ongoing viability of the Club.

WARRANTY CLAIMS

Superb Tennis have invested in extensive capital works for courts, lights, hardware, court re-surfacing and other non-fixed assets in the past year or two.

We are currently working through warranty claims on:

- · .LED lighting at Berowra
- Hardcourt re-surfacing at Mills Park and
- .EV charging station at Berowra

We will update you with our efforts as they occur. We are working to find amicable solutions as quickly as possible to these outstanding issues.

LEASE RENEWAL

Hornsby Shire Council have granted an extension to our lease for a period up to 1st of July 2025. Whilst this was good news, we are preparing our case to renew the leases for a full term already.

The lease renewal has been delayed for a number of centres within Hornsby Council area and we anticipate the tender for lease renewal will be opened within the next year.

We need the help of members and stakeholders of the club to assist in presenting the best case possible. If you would like to help, drop us a line, you might be surprised how your skills could help us get the result we all want.





Membership Renewals/ Fees & Charges

Our annual review of membership fees has been completed. The committee resolved to increase the fees for annual membership by \$10 for the coming financial year to:

\$70.00 for Adults | \$50 for Seniors and Juniors.

This is the first increase in 5 years with due consideration for inflation, budgeting and forecasts being prepared for the coming year. 
SYDNEY BADGE 2024
